

## Easel Draw Card.

### **Materials:**

Template from Website  
4 x White A4 Card  
Design Sheet from Website  
Glitter  
Gems  
Brads

### **Equipment:**

Scoreboard  
Bone folder  
Glue or double sided tape  
Quickie Glue Pen  
Scissors  
Paper trimmer

### **Instructions:**

1. Download and print the template and the design sheet from the Website.
2. Transfer all the markings onto your card to make 4 boxes and 4 wraps. Cut on the solid lines and score on the broken line. Your boxes should slide into the wraps with ease.
3. Cut out two long strips of backing paper approximately 2cm in width. Cut pieces to fit the front draw of each box and the right hand side of each wrap. Attach the pieces.
4. Punch a small hole in the front of each box and push a brad through.
5. Cut a piece of card 15cm x 15cm. Position the wrapped boxes on the card so that the front of each box faces a different direction and all you can see is the decorated side of each wrap. There should be an even gap around the card. Once you are happy attach the base of each box in place using strong tape or glue.
6. Score and fold one A4 card in half to make an A5 card blank. Measure across the fold to 15cm. Cut down the card to make a square card. Score and fold the front in half to make an easel card blank.
7. Cover the inside back of your card with backing paper. Cut out a sentiment and attach to the inside back with foam pads to act as a stopper.
8. Decorate the front of your card below the score line.
9. Attach your card to the top of the boxes matching it up with the base.
10. Add glitter highlights and gems to the front of your card.
11. Put chocolates or other small gifts in each box.
